Hungary (Magyarország) is located in Central Europe, with easy access by air, road and rail. The neighbouring countries are Austria, Croatia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia and Ukraine.

Hungary is a member of the European Union and belongs to the Schengen Area.

The country offers many diverse destinations: relatively low mountains in the North-West, the Great Plain in the East, lakes and rivers of all sorts, and many beautiful small villages and hidden gems of cities.

Szeged


Szeged is the third largest city in Hungary with a population of 160.000, located on the banks of the Tisza river and regional centre of the Southern Great Plain. The city has a rich history, which goes back to the ancient times. The University of Szeged is one of the most distinguished universities in Hungary.

The Szeged Open Air (Theatre) Festival, which has been held every year since 1931 is one of the main attractions, It has a lively sports life, famous for its handball and water polo teams, and the Szeged clubs regularly produce Olympic athletes in canoeing, swimming, rowing. Szeged has hosted several world championships in canoeing, group stages of the World Aquatics Championships water polo tournament, and the Handball European Championships.

Szeged is known as the home of paprika, a spice made from dried, powdered capsicum. Szeged is also famous for their halászlé, fish soup made of carp and catfish.







REGATTA VENUE



The venue

The National Canoeing and Rowing Centre in Szeged is located 8 kilometres from the city centre, originally built as a water reservoir and rowing course in the 1980s. The name of Szeged is well known in the international canoeing world, as their world championships, world cups keep returning to this venue. In 1989 it hosted the FISA World Junior Championships, and since then the venue has undergone several upgrades to gain its current shape. In its current form it has 8 x 12,5 m wide racing lanes for rowing, warming up and cooling down is possible in the return channel separated from the course by an island. Besides the yearly national rowing championships, Szeged hosted the World University Rowing Championships in 2010, and the Coupe de la Jeunesse in 2015, and for over 20 years an annual international regatta was organised on the Szeged rowing course.



Access

By air – The airport to be used is the Liszt Ferenc International Airport, Budapest. By rail – Hungary is part of the European railway network. Connecting train services are available from Budapest to Szeged Main Railway Station.

By road - Szeged is connected to the main European motorway network. There is easy access from the M5 motorway.

Food Services

Three shuttle bus routes will be used with an average journey time of 28 minutes.

Trailer and Team Vehicle Car Park

There is a dedicated area for boat trailer parking near the boat park. Towing vehicles can be parked in this car park.

Loading and unloading of the trailers

The boats and equipment should be carried to the boat park from the trailer car park. Please inform the Organising Committee of the expected arrival (time & date) of the boat trailer.
