

## How to reach us

We are delighted that you will participate at the Ghent International Spring Regatta 13 and 14 April 2024! With this pdf, we would like to provide information about how to reach us.

You can reach our rowing club, called 'Gentse Roei- en Sportvereniging', via the following entry on your navigation system:

street and number: Vissersdijk 1 postal code and city: 9000 Ghent

country: Belgium

**Road works 'Noorderlaan'** There are road works at the 'Noorderlaan', the street at the north side of the regatta course, which renders it only usable for bicycles. To reach the boat parks, you should 'Zuiderlaan' at the south side of the regatta course.





## Coming from a particular direction



When coming from Lille, make sure to use exit number 8 'De Pinte' to leave the E17 and use the 'N60 – Grote Steenweg' direction Ghent. This is because the connection from the E17 to the E40 at the intersection between E17 and E40 is closed due to road works.



Boat parks There are two boat parks, indicated below.



Boat park 1 is near our club house, with the following services:


- · toilets at Gentse RS
- changing rooms and showers at Gentse RS
- · erg room for warm up
- · waste collection
- · availability: from now on.

Boat park 2 is near the 'regatta village', with the following services:

- · toilets in temporary toilet container
- · waste collection
- availability: from Friday 12 April 8am on.

If you use Boat park 2, kindly take into account the following map, which details where your trailers can be parked.





**Bow numbers, weighing, withdrawals, crew changes, late entries** Please take into account where the following facilities take place:

- Collection and return of bow numbers: Gentse RS (near boat park 1).
- Weighing and physician (first aid): at the regatta village.
- Withdrawals, crew changes and late entries: at the finish tower (regatta office).
